

Official Rules

General Requirements

WIDTH: Overall width shall not exceed 2-3/4". LENGTH: Overall length shall not exceed 7".

WEIGHT: Weight shall not exceed 5 oz. for Classic Division or 8 oz. for Outlaw Division. The scales used at registration and weigh-in tables will be the official scales.

CLEARANCES: Distance between the inside of the wheels shall be no less than 1-3/4", and ground clearance should be no less than 3/8".

DETAILS: The cars must be free-wheeling with no starting devices or loose parts.

INSPECTION: Each car must pass inspection by the Official Registration and Inspection Committee before it may compete. The Inspectors have the right to disqualify those cars that do not meet official specifications. Any car that does not initially qualify will have until the end of the registration period to qualify.

IMPOUND: All cars will be impounded to the garage area after being officially weighed in and registered.

ALTERATIONS: No alterations are permitted to any car after it has been impounded. If an axle falls off, or a wheel breaks, it may be replaced at the Official Pit Repair Area with parts and methods approved. No other changes are permitted.

DECISIONS: The decisions of the Race Officials are FINAL. Any arguments with any Official by a participant or car team member will be grounds for immediate disqualification.

Classic Division

Wheel bearings, washers and bushings are prohibited. The car shall not ride on springs. Only official Cub Scout Grand Prix Pinewood Derby wheels and axles are permitted. Only dry lubricant is permitted. Details such as steering wheel and driver are permissible as long as these details do not exceed the maximum length, width and weight specifications. The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices. Each car must pass inspection, the owner will be informed of the reason for failure, and will be given time within the official weigh-in time period to make the adjustment. After final approval, cars will not be reinspected unless the car is damaged in handling or in a race.

Outlaw Division

CHASSIS: Choice of material for chassis construction is unlimited. WHEELS: Wheels can be of any material (no metal), size, or design as long as they will not damage the track.

AXLES: Any design is allowed.

WHEEL BEARINGS & SPRINGS: Bearings ARE allowed in the Open Division, as are bushings, springs, washers, etc.
